



Emergency Policy/ Plan







- 1. General: Out of concern and concern for the security and safety of students, faculty, staff and workers, Especially during emergencies and crises, it is necessary to develop a plan aimed at establishing a coordination mechanism, Effective in educational institutions to deal with emergencies and crises and in cooperation with the authorities concerned in response, Defining tasks, responsibilities and procedures that ensure everyone's safety in all circumstances.
- 2. Goal: To achieve the security and safety of students, teachers, employees and workers in the educational facility when any emergency occurs.
 - I. The Potentioal Risk:
 - Natural disasters: (floods, severe rains and winds, earthquakes, fires, infectious disease outbreaks - the emerging coronavirus, COVID-19).
 - Contrived security incidents: (quarrels, acts of violence, external attacks, leakage of gases and chemicals, loss or kidnapping) (as in the register of risks and threats to the education sector)

3. Implementation:

Concept of operations: the educational facility, with the support of the supporting authorities, deals with various emergencies and crises, according to the following stages: the preparation phase, response, and recovery, in order to preserve the lives and property and ensuring the security and safety of students and workers in the educational facility.





i. The first stage (the preparedness stage): the educational facility, before any emergency occurs, and with the support of the supporting authorities, shall work on preparing the following:
Formation of an emergency and crisis management team at the level

Work to educate students, employees and workers in the educational facility to deal with various emergencies and crises. Training on detailed procedures for emergency teams to deal with various emergencies and rescue and evacuation operations for students, faculty, staff and workers at the level of the educational facility.

Identifying and identifying assembly points, fire points, and evacuation sites in educational facilities.

Raise the necessary requirements and supplies in anticipation of any emergency in the educational facility

Activate communication channels with the concerned authorities through wired and wireless phones and hotlines, if required.

Creating a database of students, all employees, and parents, and

updating it constantly.

of the educational facility.

- ii. <u>The second stage (response)</u>: This stage starts from the occurrence of any emergency or accident in the educational facility and takes the following actions:
 - a. Promptly informing the concerned authorities in the response and giving them a brief assessment of the situation.
 - b. Activating the emergency plan of the educational facility according to the type of emergency.
 - c. Activate volunteer teams in the educational facility, if necessary.
 - d. Activate assembly points and evacuation sites and be guided to by mentors.





- e. That the concerned authorities participate in the implementation of the task, each according to their roles and responsibilities.
- f. Work according to coordination minutes, and activate communication channels.
- g. Coordinating with the respondents with the details of the event and providing a full picture of the situation.
- iii. The third stage (recovery): This stage begins with controlling the event and ends it, and takes the following actions:
 - Counting the loss of life and property.
 - Reporting incident and losses to the higher level or the school district.
 - Raising recommendations and proposals regarding resuming the study at the facility or not, and developing proposals for alternative solutions.
 - Communicate with parents and students to ensure everyone's safety.

Actions taken according to each emergency: (explained in the attached annexes)

Protection elements: Private security companies, with the cooperation of local authorities, secure the perimeter of the facilities

To prevent outside interference or burglary and theft until the event is over. Affected educational

4. Administrative Affairs:

- Means of transportation: using the means of transportation available in the educational facility for transportation, evacuation and delivery, and in the event that more means of transportation are needed, the educational region shall be informed, which in turn will provide support from other authorities.
- Medical services: seeking the help of the ambulance team and the clinic of the educational facility in principle until the arrival of support in providing first aid to the injured, and taking into account the priority of transporting the injured according to the severity of the case.
- Subsistence: In the event of a long stay in the educational facility for any emergency circumstances, the request is submitted to the educational district with the necessity to provide food for the existing numbers and according to the agreed method, as the school district coordinates with the concerned authorities to provide the needs of food and drinking

5. Leadership and Communication:

• Leadership:

A suitable location is identified and prepared in the administration of the educational facility for the process of managing the event and communicating with the concerned authorities.
